TEACHING ENGLISH THROUGH ICT

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Abstract:

In the current scenario, English exists in almost all fields of life. It has also gained the status of a global language. There is a vast gap between the students learned knowledge from the educational institutions and the knowledge needed in real life situations outside the classroom. In fact, there is no correlation between the learning of a language and using it in everyday life. Learning English is a big challenge for the learners. One of the best strategies is to make students to meet their

challenges and needs by using ICT (Information and Communication Technology) in the ESL classroom. Like English, ICT occupies a major place as a means of effective communication. Hence it is considered as the finest strategic technique to teach the English language through ICT. There is an extreme need to create interactive media and hypermedia where computing and communication technologies are combined to provide computer-based education. Traditional classrooms Vs ICT classrooms:

The chief objective of Teaching is not only giving information but to develop understanding and application of the concepts, decision making ability, speed and vocabulary, improving comprehension, self-concept and value clarification, expression power, reasoning and thinking power, judgment and tolerance and ambiguity, proper study habits, scientific temper, risk-taking capacity, etc. It is extremely difficult to achieve all these objectives with the present infrastructure, availability of teachers and class size, training of teachers etc.

Using ICT in teaching the English language:

ICT can be defined as "a diverse set of technological tools and resources which used to communicate, create, disseminate, store, retrieve and manage information." Computers, Internet, What's App, Skype, broadcasting technologies like radio and television, Films, LCD projector, YouTube, Mobile phones, you etc are some of the most important applications of ICT and can be used in Teaching English.

Computers:

The computer is an electronic device which stores unlimited lessons or references and can be accessed from anywhere at any time and accurately. Through Computer Aided Learning and Teaching (CALT), teachers are trained to use technology in designing and producing instructional materials. Computers can be used to develop a lesson plan, self-instructional

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modules, test construction, quiz, puzzles, etc can enhance quality learning at less cost. Computer knowledge is very useful for teachers to learn how to teach students. Computers are also useful to draw and print graphs etc. Moreover, Computers can generate and print appropriate question papers and score the objective type answer sheets including multiple choices, true or false etc.

Internet:

Computer technology has provided Internet and is merely a source of information available in the form of articles, conferences, and courses. In the educational field, the Internet provides the students with a wide range of collection of English language texts in various discipline departments. Students can improve their English language in terms of practicing these texts at any time without the teacher's assistance. Students may use many software applications available on the Internet at free of cost to practice the English language. By reading English articles, stories reading skill will be improved and through some group activities speaking skill, by listening to audio aids listening skill, by practicing activities available on internet writing skill will be improved. The teachers and learners can choose the difficulty level they want to train.

Skype:

Skype is one of the developments of this 21st century and it provides boundless possibilities for the teachers and students to collaborate with each other from anywhere at any time in the world. It provides immense opportunities for the teachers and students in terms of having English classes in face to face mode through online from anywhere. Using Skype the teachers could monitor students' homework regularly in order to help the learners. Students also do work collaboratively with other students for their research projects. It will help them with professional development.

Radio and Television:

The radio and television are one of the significant useful audiovisual aids for teaching the English Language. These two are the most important devices for distant education. It promotes self-learning by having distance education. Many English teaching programmes are broadcasted by All India Radio and the materials are prepared by the EFLU, Hyderabad by the ELT experts in India. They can also be recorded and used in the ESL classrooms (Krishnaswami, N Krishnaswami Lalitha). The radio appeals to ears but the television appeals both to the ears and eyes which helps to develop pronunciation, speaking skills, and listening skills etc. Radio and Television could bring real-life experience into the classroom. Therefore the teaching is lively.

Films:

Films offer the reading materials in the form of stories which helps as a technological aid to present systematic knowledge of the subject. The fact is that knowledge acquired from the

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films has an everlasting effect (Rai B.C). We can also make students to play Shakespeare plays while teaching English Literature in the classroom which provides self-learning.

LCD Projector:

An LCD projector is a very useful technological device and alternative aid to the chalkboard. Movies, stories, powerpoint presentations, pictures on transparencies can be projected on a screen. It saves time while preparing the materials in advance. For this use, appropriate infrastructure is required for the use of such kind of equipment. (Krishnaswami N., Krishnaswami Lalitha).

Mobile phones:

Mobile phones are another technological tools which have a wide range of various applications. The teacher can use these applications in the ESL classrooms by asking them to prepare documentaries using the camera in the mobile phones. Understanding the significant impact of the English language, Eenadu Telugu daily newspaper is conducting spoken English programmes through mobile phones to reach the rural people. This is how mobile phones can be exploited for teaching English.

YouTube:

YouTube is another technological device and its videos can be used in the ELT classrooms to improve the proficiency level of ESL learners. It helps the learners to teach different aspects of English to enhance pronunciations, accents, vocabulary, voice modulation, and sentence formation etc. The main advantage of using YouTube in the ESL classroom is that it offers authentic examples of everyday English used in real life situations. Therefore the teacher can use it as an innovative pedagogical tool for teaching the English language.

Therefore ICT can be a good teaching aid to develop overall proficiency in English. If the teacher is well trained with necessary online training in order to update her knowledge, automatically the student will be trained well. It is possible only through using ICT in the ESL classroom
